* <u>PROPOSED BYLAWS CHANGE, HOW BYLAW SHALL READ IF ACCEPTED AT STATE MEETING:</u>	<p><u>Proposed</u> (red=committee revisions to proposed language, additions in <i>green italics</i>)</p> <p>B. In addition to vacancies created by death or resignation, in counties with populations of less than 500,000 persons, a vacancy shall exist in the State <i>or County</i> Committee when a member moves from the county from which he/she was elected. In addition to vacancies created by death or resignation in counties with populations of 500,000 or more persons, a vacancy shall exist in the State <i>or County</i> Committee when a member moves from the legislative district from which elected. In addition to the vacancy in the office of a PC as set forth in the bylaws, pursuant to the provisions of Title 16, Section 821-B, a vacancy shall be as set forth in Title 38, Section 291. A vacancy shall also be as set forth in A.R.S. 16-822(D).</p> <p>No party official shall recommend a person to fill a vacancy in the state or County or a precinct committee who has, during the previous year, (i) donated to any general election candidate for public office other than a Republican, (ii) volunteered for such a candidate, or (iii) made public statements advocating for the election of such a candidate. This paragraph shall not apply if there is no Republican nominated as a general election candidate.</p> <p><b><u>Reason for Proposed Change:</u></b> Clarifying that the rule applies to state and county.</p>
